

UPDATE ON THE NOMINEES TO THE VACANT POSITION IN THE CCP BOARD OF TRUSTEES

1. The CCP sent a letter to the Governance Commission for GOCCs (GCG) in October 2020 submitting the names and CVs of the following nominees:

- 1.1. Mr. Moises Benedict Carandang
Co-founder and President of Tuldok Animation Studios
- 1.2. Mr. Lorenzo Chan, Jr.
Chief Executive Officer and President, Pioneer Life, Inc.
- 1.3. Mr. Teodoro “Junie” del Mundo
Co-founder, Chair and Chief Executive, The EON Group
- 1.4. Mr. Michael Rodriguez
Manager, Macquarie Infrastructure and Real Assets,
Manila, Philippines

2. The GCG informed CCP just recently that it will send a formal reply to CCP apologizing for the delay in their action and informing CCP that the nominees shall be asked to submit clearances from the Civil Service Commission, National Bureau of Investigation, Sandiganbayan and Ombudsman. They do recognize though that it will be quite difficult to apply for these clearances during this period of pandemic.

3. Given the situation, the CCP President as Chair of the Nomination and Remunerations Committee recommends the

submission of the list of nominees to the Presidential Management Staff (PMS).

UPDATE ON THE APPLICANTS FOR THE VACANT POSITION OF
CCP VICE PRESIDENT FOR FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION –
(Salary Grade 27)

1. There are two applicants from the first posting of vacancy in December 2020:

1.1. Mr. Manuel B. Cabalejo

Mr. Cabalejo is currently the Department Manager (Salary Grade 26) of CCP Internal Audit Department. He applied for two open positions: the VP for Finance and Administration (SG 27) and the Department Manager for Financial Services (SG26).

He is a CPA and holds a Master's Degree in Government Management from PLM and a Master's Degree in Information System from Southern Cross University as an Aus-Aid Scholar. He transferred to the CCP in July 2013 from the Department of Education where his last position was Internal Auditor V in the Internal Audit Service of the Central Office.

1.2. Mr. Ramil R. Tan

Mr. Tan was the former Executive Director of Institute of Integrated Electrical Engineers of the Philippines, Inc. (IIEE), an organization of electrical practitioners which was founded in 1975 and now has 47,000 members. He was also the Executive Director of the Pasig River Rehabilitation Commission.

He holds a Master's Degree in Public Administration from University of Northern Philippines and took up units in Bachelor of Laws (Juris Doctor) in San Sebastian College.

2. The HRMD will schedule a preliminary interview with the applicants. While Mr. Tan still has to submit some documents that will support his record of training programs, it is recommended that he be included in the list of interviewees. The CCP President will be inviting the Trustees: Dr. Laya, Mr. Endriga and Ms. Del Pilar to comprise the panel of interviewers.
