4. Bid must be accompanied by a photocopy of current Mayors Permit, DTI or SEC Registration of the bidder.
5. The original copy of the Mayors Permit, DTI, or SEC Registration shall be presented by the winning bidder prior to formal issuance of Notice of Award for validation purposes.



6. All items for disposal are available for inspection on February 21, 2024 at 10.00 am, at Folk Arts Theater and Manila Film Center Mechanical Room, CCP Complex, Pasay City. After the inspection, a pre bid conference will follow at the Finance and Admin front lawn or at a place deem safe by the DC.

The CCP reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids without offering any reason, to waive any formality or technicality, to determine and to award to any bidder with the highest complying bid and whose proposal is deemed most advantageous to the CCP, provided the offer is not less than the minimum bid price.
