**RECOMMENDATION OF AWARD
DISMANTLING OF EXISTING RIGGING SYSTEM AND ORCHESTRA LIFT
SECTION 35.6 (b) - NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER RESTORATIVE WORKS FOR THE
CONSERVATION OF HISTORICAL AND CULTURALLY SIGNIFICANT STRUCTURES AND
ARTWORKS**

WHEREAS, the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) is undertaking the rehabilitation of the CCP Main Building, including the upgrading of theater systems and facilities at the Tanghalang Nicanor Abelardo (Main Theater);

WHEREAS, the Dismantling of Existing Rigging System and Orchestra Lift was identified as a critical component of this restoration, with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Twenty-One Million Nine Hundred Twenty Thousand Three Hundred Sixty and 25/100 Pesos (₱21,920,360.25) inclusive of VAT and other applicable government taxes;

WHEREAS, the approved Terms of Reference (TOR) provides that the scope of work involves the dismantling of complex and highly specialized theater systems, including but not limited to:

- Manual and motorized fly bar systems
- Counterweight rigging systems
- Mechanical lifting equipment such as the orchestra lift
- Associated electrical and control systems

WHEREAS, the TOR further establishes that the required works involve complex, high-risk, and highly technical activities, necessitating specialized expertise in:

- Theatrical rigging systems engineering
- Structural rigging dismantling
- Mechanical lifting systems
- Electrical disconnection of motorized rigging components
- Safe handling of suspended loads and overhead equipment

WHEREAS, a Market Study (*Annex A*) was conducted to assess the availability and capability of contractors within the Philippine market for theater rigging dismantling works;

WHEREAS, the Market Study established that:

- The Philippine theater rigging industry has a limited number of qualified contractors with direct experience in permanent theater rigging systems;
- International manufacturers primarily supply equipment and do not provide dismantling services locally;
- Most local contractors are engaged in general construction, event staging, or industrial rigging, with limited specialization in theatrical rigging systems;
- Only a few contractors possess the required expertise in dismantling complex stage rigging and orchestra lift systems;

WHEREAS, the Market Study further identified that Stage Riggers Inc. demonstrates:

- Direct and relevant experience in theatrical rigging systems
- Proven capability in handling suspended loads and rigging equipment
- Availability of specialized tools, equipment, and trained personnel
- Operational familiarity with performance venue environments

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) recognizes that this procurement constitutes a **highly specialized and technical undertaking**, requiring not only engineering competence but also **industry-specific expertise in theatrical rigging systems**, where improper dismantling may result in:

- Safety risks to personnel
- Structural damage to the theater facility
- Loss or damage to reusable components
- Disruption to the overall rehabilitation program



WHEREAS, based on the TOR and Market Study, resorting to Negotiated Procurement under Section 35.6 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 12009 (New Government Procurement Act) is justified to ensure:

- Safety of personnel and theater infrastructure
- Proper dismantling methodology and sequencing
- Preservation of reusable components
- Compliance with industry standards and best practices

WHEREAS, procurement of restorative works intended for the conservation of historical and culturally significant structures and artworks may be conducted through Negotiated Procurement, to ensure the engagement of qualified specialists and contractors with proven expertise;

WHEREAS, the BAC finds that the dismantling of the existing rigging system and orchestra lift:

- Requires specialized theatrical rigging expertise and engineering competence;
- Involves complex systems suitable for general contractors;
- Has limited market availability of qualified providers;
- Necessitates engagement of a contractor with demonstrated industry-specific experience;

WHEREAS, the CCP-Bids and Awards Committee (CCP-BAC) invited Stage Riggers, Inc. for a negotiation on 13 March 2026 (*Annex B – Negotiation Table*). The CCP-BAC reconfirms the proposal and the conformance of Stage Riggers, Inc. to the Terms of Reference and accepted the contract proposal of Eighteen Million Pesos (₱18,000,000.00) inclusive of VAT and other applicable government taxes;

WHEREAS, the CCP-BAC finds Stage Riggers, Inc., to be legally, technically, and financially capable of undertaking the Dismantling of Existing Rigging System and Orchestra Lift;

NOW THEREFORE, the CCP Bids and Awards Committee (CCP-BAC), hereby **RESOLVES** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to recommend to the Head of Procuring Entity,

- a. The Negotiated Procurement Mode of Procurement for the **Dismantling of Existing Rigging System and Orchestra Lift**, amounting to **Eighteen Million Pesos (₱18,000,000.00)** inclusive of VAT and other applicable government taxes; and
- b. The Award of the contract to **Stage Riggers, Inc.**

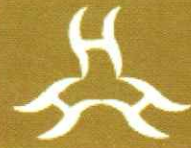

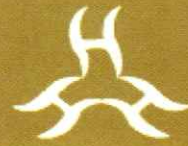
